

Meeting adjourned.



Ford Scores Podium Finish With New GT3 At Le Mans



Lynne Lind missed the June IEMC General Membership meeting for a good reason, it was her and our club founder's birthday and she took a drive with her son Aaron, in the fastback, to visit Carl Lind's marker at the Veterans Cemetery and was treated to lunch and dinner by her daughter Andrea.

IEMC extends its thanks for the legacy the Lind family has with the club, and offers its best wishes to for the future.

The new Mustang GT3 made its debut at the 24 hour race at le Mans with great success. All three Mustangs that entered the race finished the race, which is an accomplishment in its own right, and one of them achieved a podium finish. The #88 Mustang, driven by Olsen, Roda, and Pederson finished in third place, while the #44 GT3, with drivers Mies, Hartshorne and Tuck, narrowly missed the trophy positions ending up in fourth place.



The race at the 8+ mile course at Le Mans is a test of endurance, team work, engineering, strategy, stamina, and mental toughness. Only the best machines and drivers are able to conquer its challenges and complete the full day of competition. Congratulations to Ford for providing a vehicle that well represented the company and the country with such fantastic finishes.

It was patterned after CSX2299 just as it appeared in the 1965-12 Hours of Sebring race... and it's about as close as one can get to possessing and driving That Real McCoy. Peter Brock's CSX2299 was driven to the checkered flag at Sebring in the GT III Class by legendary drivers Bob Bondurant (aka "Bondo") and French Formula One driver Jo Schlesser (Joseph Théodule Marie Schlesser)... a skilled and popular driver who perished in a spectacular crash on the second lap of the French Grand Prix at Rouen in 1968.

The original CSX2299 is owned by the Larry H. Miller Family Foundation in Utah, and is customarily stabled and on display in the Shelby American Collection museum in Boulder, Colorado.

- VIN# FFR2758CP (It was the 17th FFR "Type 65" Coupe produced... the tally is almost 1,000 now).
- Coupe body/chassis package shipped to me in June, 2001; it was first registered in summer, 2016.
- 6,900 original miles [11,100 km] logged as of end of May, 2024.
- This CSX2299 Coupe dupe is a crowd pleaser at shows and is typically mobbed by enthusiasts.
