NASCAR team RFK Racing showed up at Phoenix Raceway for a limited testing session at the end of January, with a special edition paint scheme honoring the late Ford racer Kern Block. The number 6 Mustang, driven by Team co-owner Brad Keselowski, featured the graphics made famous by Block when he raced Ford Escorts and Fiesta Rally 2's in World Rally Championships, starting in the 1990's.

Block started the sportswear company DC Shoes before embarking on a long and successful career in WRC, drifting (in his 1400 HP AWD Mustang), and offroad racing. Block had developed friendships with racers in other series including NASCAR. Block died in a snowmobile accident in early January 2023.

The two-tone grey checked pattern with vertical stripes with flat black rear graphics mimic the fan favorite cars that Black raced. In addition, his name and number are located on the name rail and one quarter window also includes his skull logo.

Keselowski, the 2012 NASCAR Cup Series Champion, became part owner in what is now RFK racing in 2022 after moving from Penske Racing at the end of the 2021 season. His first year with the Roush team was met with mixed results, but they anticipate more consistency in 2023.
