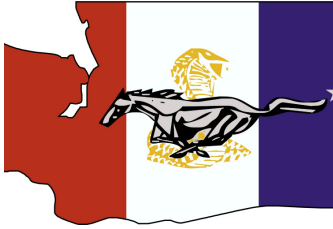

- C-4 Automatic Transmission
- Current Paint is ten years old
- Paint is the original color
- Carpet and interior are original
- Wheel covers: Spoke caps with spinners
- All of the glass appears original with the exception of the front windshield
- The car has been driven only 10,000 miles since 2003
- The car has been owned by the same family since it was delivered from the dealership
- The car has replacement radial tires, of which about 65% of the tread remains
- The car does not appear to have any surface rust or any the inherent rust issues that are commonly present on cars of this age
- The car has been stored indoors for all of its existence
- Trunk is intact and is in excellent condition
- Engine bay and engine are not detailed out, however they appear to be in excellent condition and are comprised of all original equipment
- The only add-ons that were not factory ordered are the vacuum cruise control and aftermarket air-conditioning that was installed at the dealership
- The car has an exterior chrome luggage rack mounted on the trunk lid. This was common and may have been added at the dealership
- Front drivers seat has some separations at the fabric seams
- Interior package is standard, as opposed to the deluxe package.
