

'Stang of the Month: Francine Dober's 2004 40th Anniv. GT

I purchased my 2004 Ford Mustang GT convertible, coincidentally, 40th Anniversary Edition on February 14th 2010 while wishing myself Happy Valentine's Day! Crimson Red, exclusive to the 40th Anniversary package and the rarest of the 3 colors along with Black and Oxford White. Ford produced 5700 of the 40th Anniversary editions. 2004 was the final year for production at the Dearborn Michigan plant with it's final car being a crimson red GT convertible. "Mustang Sally" was blaring over a loudspeaker as it rolled off the assembly line. Dearborn was Fords oldest manufacturing plant, an 86 year old factory built under the guidance of founder Henry Ford and later the birthplace of the iconic Mustang. Ford moved production from Dearborn to a factory in Flat Rock, southwest of Detroit. That move allowed Ford to cut costs up to \$2 billion over the next decade.



I named my car Ruby Slipper from the Wizard of Oz. Dorothy's ruby slippers have the power to grant wishes and transport people to various locations. They symbolize the power we all have within ourselves to make our dreams become reality. Ruby Slipper is still a virgin, untouched, stock, just like she rolled off the assembly line. That also makes her somewhat rare and that's how I like it. I am the second owner.

I was working as a receptionist at a local Harley-Davidson dealership when I bought her. I served as the historian, photographer and newsletter editor for the local HOG Chapter. All of that hit the finish line when the owner decided to file for bankruptcy.


